





사람의 감정을 나타내는 동사들은 분사 형태로 형용사처럼 쓰인다. 감정을 유발하는 대상인 사물을 묘사할 때는 현재분사를, 감정을 느끼는 대상인 사람을 묘사할 때는 과거분사를 사용한다.

- •The news was **surprising**. (그 뉴스는 놀라웠다.)
- · She was **surprised** by the news. (그녀는 그 뉴스에 놀랐다.)
- •The lecture was **boring**. (그 강의는 지루했다.)
- · I was **bored** during the lecture. (나는 강의 동안 지루했다.)


