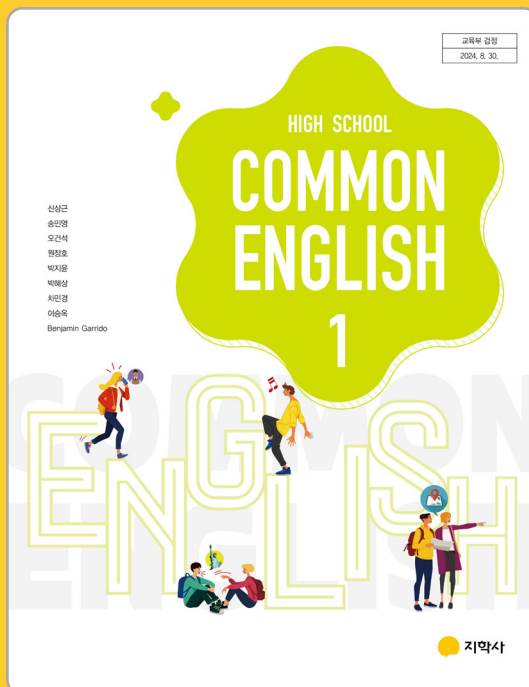

Common Mistakes

감정을 나타내는 형용사의 분사형 (현재분사 vs. 과거분사)

사람의 감정을 나타내는 동사들은 분사 형태로 형용사처럼 쓰인다. 감정을 유발하는 대상인 사물을 묘사할 때는 현재분사를, 감정을 느끼는 대상인 사람을 묘사할 때는 과거분사를 사용한다.

- The news was **surprising**. (그 뉴스는 놀라웠다.)
- She was **surprised** by the news. (그녀는 그 뉴스에 놀랐다.)
- The lecture was **boring**. (그 강의는 지루했다.)
- I was **bored** during the lecture. (나는 강의 동안 지루했다.)
